### Ettiquette

It is imperative that the Society rules are read and understood in conjunction with the information below..

As there was an AGM held at the end of the last season, there are amendments to the current formats that are now in force.

- Price per round to remain at £40.
- Evening meal has been removed except for the four majors.
- Each meeting (except for the majors) will be a morning sausage or bacon roll, tea or coffee, followed by golf.
- Team players will be drawn from the pool of regular attendees.
- Balls and vouchers are to remain.
- A fourth major has been added. The Captains Day has been added to the final meeting of the season.

As a responsible society member we expect you to have a basic knowledge of the Rules of Golf and course etiquette. Please be aware that you are expected to understand the Rules of Golf as disqualifications will be applied for any serious breach.

One annoying point of order is that no member should stand at the side of a player on the tee or on the green. This is poor etiquette and can be off putting to the player. If you are not teeing off or putting you should stand behind the player.

Society membership requires the wearing of a Society polo shirt on the course and a Society evening shirt and tie for the four majors. These will have to be purchased by you through the society. Any existing member that does not have the above, should purchase them in time for the forthcoming season.

The dress code for the society is particularly important and **must** be observed. Any player who refuses to observe the society dress code, which is the same as club dress code, will be asked to leave the club and society.

If we can improve our times around the courses we play through our understanding of etiquette and rules, we will have no trouble getting return invites next year.

There also needs a lot more commitment from some of the members. If the society is going to continue into the future and the costs kept down, then we need to have regular attendance from the members and not relying on the few that do regularly attend.
